Dear Northern Lights member,

I'm Jim Woodward, and I've served for eight years on the Northern Lights Board of Directors, representing District 7. I am asking for your vote in the upcoming NLI board elections.

Northern Lights provides electricity to nearly 23,000 homes and businesses across northern Idaho and northwest Montana. We are a nonprofit electrical cooperative. Our consumers are our members – that means you get to VOTE on who will serve on the board of directors.

I've worked my past two terms as a director to:

- **KEEP RATES LOW.** NLI has not raised rates for more than five years even with recent high inflation.
- **RETURN YOUR MONEY TO YOU.** I promoted NLI's new method to return additional capital credits to our member ratepayers.
- **REDUCE CO-OP DEBT.** I've continually advocated debt reduction and we've reduced co-op debt by \$5 million since I joined the board.

I'm also NLI's representative to the statewide electrical association. I am actively involved in negotiations for upcoming contracts with the Bonneville Power Administration. This will determine our access to the Northwest hydroelectric system and the cost of our electricity for the next 20 years.






■NO rate increases
